

# Advent Calender Scarf 2010

## Day 2

### Spacer Section

There is a spacer section between the single pattern for each day. It's a way to separate the pattern and to adjust the number of stitches. The spacer section asks for 86 stitches. Sometimes you have to increase or decrease one or two stitches, please follow the instructions.

If you don't want to use beads knit the marked stitch (P).

Knit row 1 to 8 once, repeat the number of stitches 16 times. Decrease 1 stitch after the edge stitches while knitting the first row (86 stitches), increase one stitch by knitting in front and back of the fourth stitch while knitting the last row of spacer section (87 stitches)

I = k1 = knit 1 stitch

O = yo = yarn over

/ = k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

\ = k2tog tbl = knit 2 stitches together through back loop

P = knit 1 stitch and place one bead = put the bead on a crochet hook (small enough for your bead), lift the stitch with the hook from the left hand needle and push the bead to the stitch, put stitch back to left hand needle and knit)

### Written instruction for spacer section

**Row 1 to 4 and 6 to 8:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, knit till end of row

**Row 5 (right side row):** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k2, \*k2tog, yo, add 1 bead to the next stitch and knit, yo, k2tog tbl, repeat from \* 15 more times, end with k3

## Pattern Day 2

### Edge stitches

There are 3 edge stitches on each side. Slip the first stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k2, knit pattern stitches and end with k3.

On the wrong side slip the first stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k2, follow the pattern and end with k3.

These 6 stitches are not shown in the charted instruction.

The chart only shows right side rows. Start with the edge stitches, k1, repeat pattern stitches, k2 and end with k3 for the edge stitches.

Knit wrong side rows as follows:

Slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k2, purl all pattern stitches, end with k3.

Knit rows 1 to 14 twice.

I = k1 = knit 1 stitch

O = yo = yarn over

/ = k2tog = knit 2 together

\ = k2tog tbl = knit 2 together through back loop

N = 1 nupp = make 7 stitches out of this stitch alternating k1, yo, end with k1, purl these stitches together on wrong side row

### Written instruction

**Row 1:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k3, \*k1, k2tog tbl, k7, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, repeat from \* 5 more times, end with k5

**Row 2 and all other wrong side rows:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k2, purl till 3 stitches before end of row, k3 (purl together the 7 nupp stitches)

**Row 3:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k3, \*k1, k2tog tbl, k6, yo, k1, yo, nupp, k2tog, repeat from \* 5 more times, end with k5

**Row 5:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k3, \*k1, k2tog tbl, k5, yo, k1, yo, nupp, k1, k2tog, repeat from \* 5 more times, end with k5

**Row 7:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k3, \*k1, k2tog tbl, k4, yo, k1, yo, nupp, k2, k2tog, repeat from \* 5 more times, end with k5

**Row 9:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k3, \*k1, k2tog tbl, k3, yo, k1, yo, nupp, k3, k2tog, repeat from \* 5 more times, end with k5

**Row 11:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k3, \*k1, k2tog tbl, k2, yo, k1, yo, nupp, k4, k2tog, repeat from \* 5 more times, end with k5

**Row 13:** slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front, k3, \*k1, k2tog tbl, k1, yo, k1, yo, nupp, k5, k2tog, repeat from \* 5 more times, end with k5

Knit rows 1 to 14 twice.
